Our Father ~



The children of Israel murmured in the desert. Then the Lord said, 'I will rain bread from heaven for you.' (Ex 16; 2, 4)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus went ashore and saw a great throng; he had compassion on them and healed their sick (Mt 14; 14)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said, 'Give them something to eat.' His disciples said, 'We only have five loaves and two fish.' (Mt 14; 16,17)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus took the loaves and the fish, and looking up to heaven he blessed them. And everyone ate, and they were all satisfied. (Mt 13; 19, 20)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said, 'The bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.' (Jn 6:32-33)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said, 'I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger' (Jn 6:34-35)

Hail Mary ~

This is the bread that comes down from heaven so that you may eat it and not die. (Jn 6:47-50)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks he broke it and said, 'This is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me.' (1 Cor 11; 24)

Hail Mary ~

In the same way also the cup, saying, 'This is the new covenant in my blood; do this as often as you drink it in remembrance of me.' (1 Cor 11; 25)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said, 'A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another even as I have loved you.' (Jn 13; 34)

Glory be to the Father ~



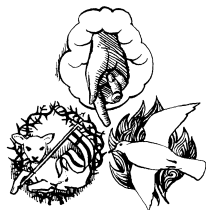
O Lord Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell; lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of thy mercy.

O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary. Pray for us O holy Mother of God, That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Amen

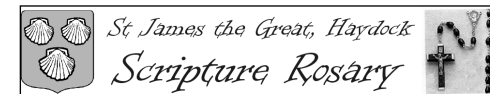

We ask that the gift of Hope might increase in us and in all the world:

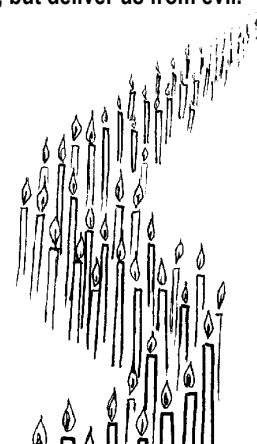

The First Luminous Mystery – The Baptism in the Jordan

Heavenly Father, in the sacrament of baptism we were joined to your body the church. We pray for all members of your church, that together we may serve you in the world.

John the baptist said, I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. (Mt 3:11)

Hail Mary ~

I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. (Lk 3:16)

Hail Mary ~

He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. (Mt 3:11)

Hail Mary ~

His winnowing fan is in his hand to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his barn. (Lk 3:17)

Hail Mary ~

Then Jesus came to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. (Mt 3:13)

Hail Mary ~

John tried to prevent him, saying, 'I need to be baptized by you, and yet you are coming to me?' (Mt 3:14)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said to him in reply, 'It is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.' (Mt 3:15)

Hail Mary ~

After Jesus was baptized, behold, the heavens opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming upon him. (Mt 3:16)

Hail Mary ~

And a voice came from the heavens, saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased. (Mt 3:17)

John the baptist said, Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God. (Jn 1:34)

The Second Luminous Mystery – The Wedding at Cana of Galilee

Heavenly Father, your Son revealed his power to the world in an act of compassion: help us by our compassion to show forth his saving power in our world

Our Father ~



There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited. (Jn 2:1-2)

Hail Mary ~

When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, 'They have no wine.' (Jn 2:3)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said to her, 'Woman, what have you to do with me? My hour has not yet come. (Jn 2:4)

Hail Mary ~

His mother said to the servants, 'Do whatever he tells you.' (Jn 2:5)

Hail Mary ~

Now there were six stone jars there for Jewish ceremonial washings, each holding about twenty gallons. (Jn 2:6)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus told the servants, 'Fill the jars with water.' So they filled them to the brim. (Jn 2:7)

Hail Mary ~

Then he told them, 'Draw some out now and take it to the steward of the feast.' So they took it. (Jn 2:8)

Hail Mary ~

The steward tasted the water that had become wine, without knowing where it came from (although the servants who had drawn the water knew) (Jn 2:9)

Hail Mary ~

He said to the Bridegroom, 'Everyone serves good wine first, and then the poor wine; but you have kept the good wine until now.' (Jn 2:10)

Hail Mary ~

This, the first of his signs, Jesus did in Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples believed in him. (Jn 2:11)

The Third Luminous Mystery – The Proclamation of the Kingdom

Heavenly Father, grant to all mankind the wisdom to perceive the kingdom of heaven and to strive for it, both in this world and the next.

In the synagogue, Jesus read Isaiah's words, 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor.' (Lk 4:16-18)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said, 'Today this scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.' 'The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel. (Lk 4:21, Mk 1:15)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus said, 'No one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. (Jn 3:5)

Hail Mary ~

God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life, (Jn 3:16)

Hail Mary ~

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life. (Jn 4:36)

Hail Mary ~

The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found - then covered it up. (Mt 13: 44)

Hail Mary ~

Then in his joy, that man went and sold all that he had - and bought the field! (Mt 13; 44)

Hail Mary ~

The kingdom of heaven is like a merchant who found a pearl of great value: he went and sold all that he had and bought it. (Mt 13; 45,46)

Hail Mary ~

The kingdom of heaven is like leaven which a woman took and hid in the flour until all the flour was leavened (Mt 13; 33)

Hail Mary ~

Every scribe trained for the kingdom of heaven is like a householder who brings out of his treasure what is new and also what is old. (Mt 13; 52)

The Fourth Luminous Mystery – The Transfiguration of Our Lord

Heavenly Father, all too easily we fail to see your majesty. As we live our lives on earth, grant us the vision to see Our Lord in glory, and follow him in faithfulness.

Our Father ~



Jesus took Peter, James, and John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. (Mk 9:2)

Hail Mary ~

He was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them. (Mk 9:2-3)

Hail Mary ~

Then Elijah appeared to them along with Moses, and they were conversing with Jesus. (Mk 9:4)

Hail Mary ~

Peter said, 'Rabbi, it is good that we are here! Let us make three tents: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.' (Mk 9:5)

Hail Mary ~

While he was still speaking, a cloud came and cast a shadow over them, and they were afraid. (Lk 9:34)

Hail Mary ~

Then from the cloud came a voice that said, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.' (Mt 17:5)

Hail Mary ~

When the disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid. (Mt 17:6)

Hail Mary ~

But Jesus came and touched them, saying, 'Rise, and do not be afraid.' (Mt 17:7)

Hail Mary ~

And when the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone. (Mt 17:8)

Hail Mary ~

Jesus charged them, 'Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead.' (Mt 17:9)

Hail Mary ~

Glory be to the Father ~
